

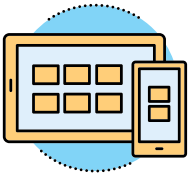
# COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT SUMMARY REPORT



## WHO PARTICIPATED?

Participants included residents, visitors, business owners and services users.

**1,100+ community members participated** in stage one consultation activities



## HOW DID THEY PARTICIPATE?

**210 people added an idea online**

**400+** visited one of 5 listening posts

**45 people attended an Advisory Committee Workshop**

**350 people participated in targeted discussions**

**21 people made written submissions**

**32 people contributed on Facebook**
