









SMITH STREET INTERFACE PRECEDENT-









OTTER STREET INTERFACE **PRECEDENT-**




View looking north-west towards Smith Street intersection. Render view shows generous seating opportunities around terrace edges with clear view-lines up Otter Street.




CONCEPT DESIGN TREES -
